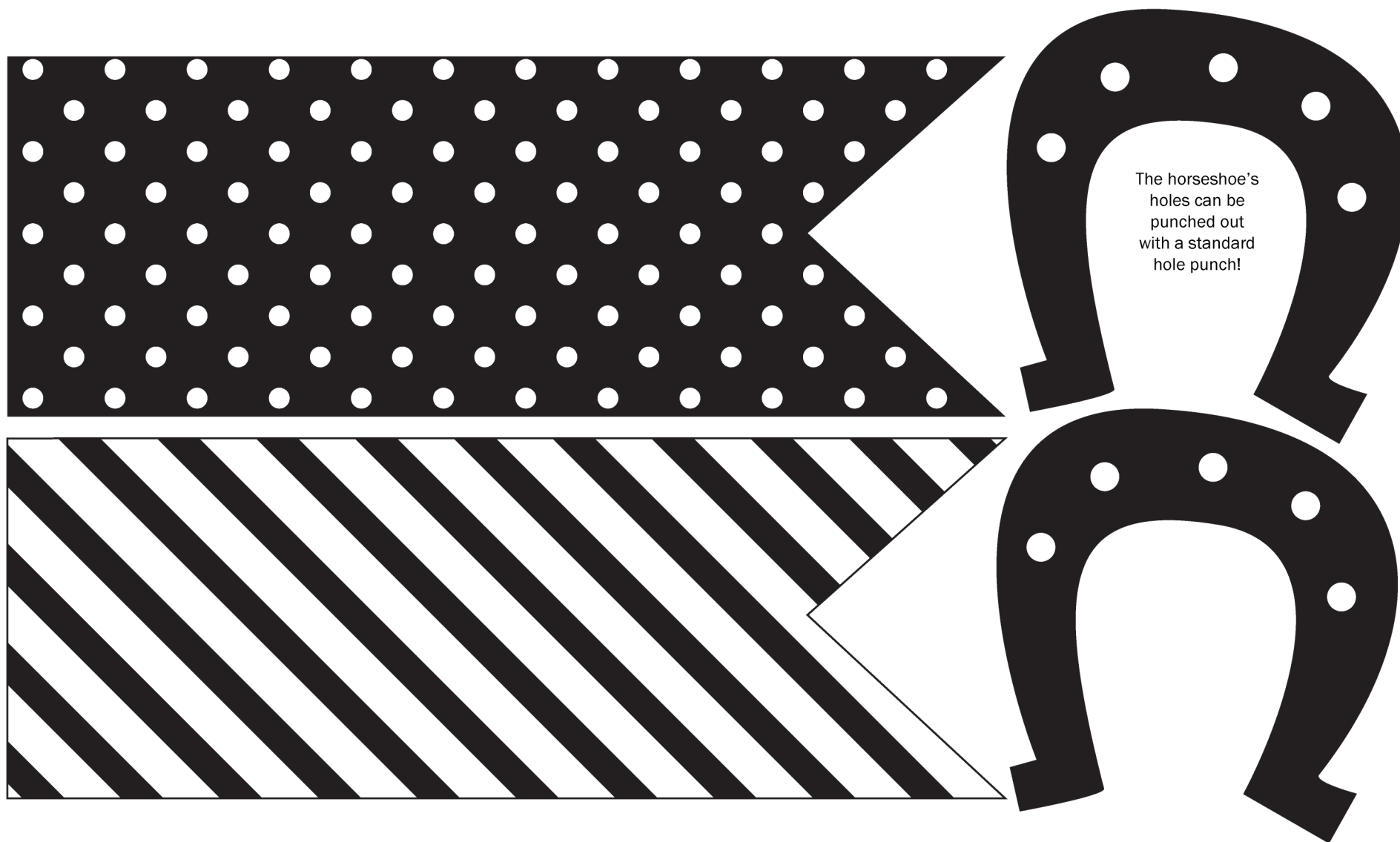


INSTRUCTIONS FOR DIY GOLD FOIL: Print this page on cardstock in black and white on a printer that uses toner not ink – this part is critical since it is the toner that allows the gold foil to adhere. Cut out each pennant and horseshoe shape. Cut a piece of hot-stamping gold foil (direct link to source for this foil can be found on PagingSupermom.com), to fit your shapes. Place the foil with the back side touching the black printing on your shapes and put inside of the folder that came with your laminator (a file folder will work). Run through the heated laminator. Peel away the foil sheet and try not to squeal as you unveil your now metallic gold pieces!



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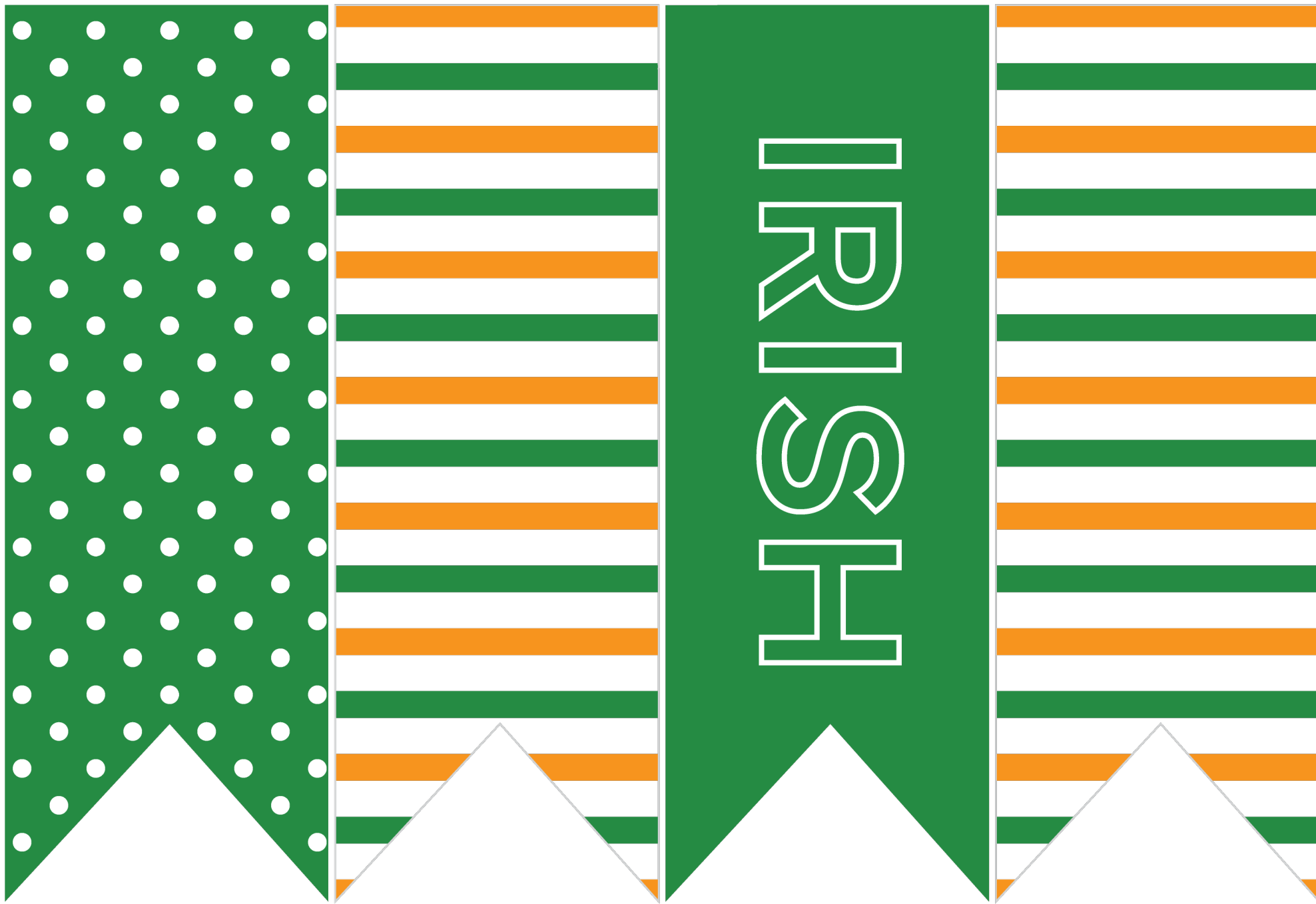


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TIP: Use a 2 or 2.5-inch hole punch to cut these out.





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
