Cut out the ocean labels below and color then cut out the landmasses (on the following pages). Using school glue or Modge Podge apply the labels to your globe. Once labels are applied, brush on a generous layer of your glue to the entire globe to seal and protect your work.

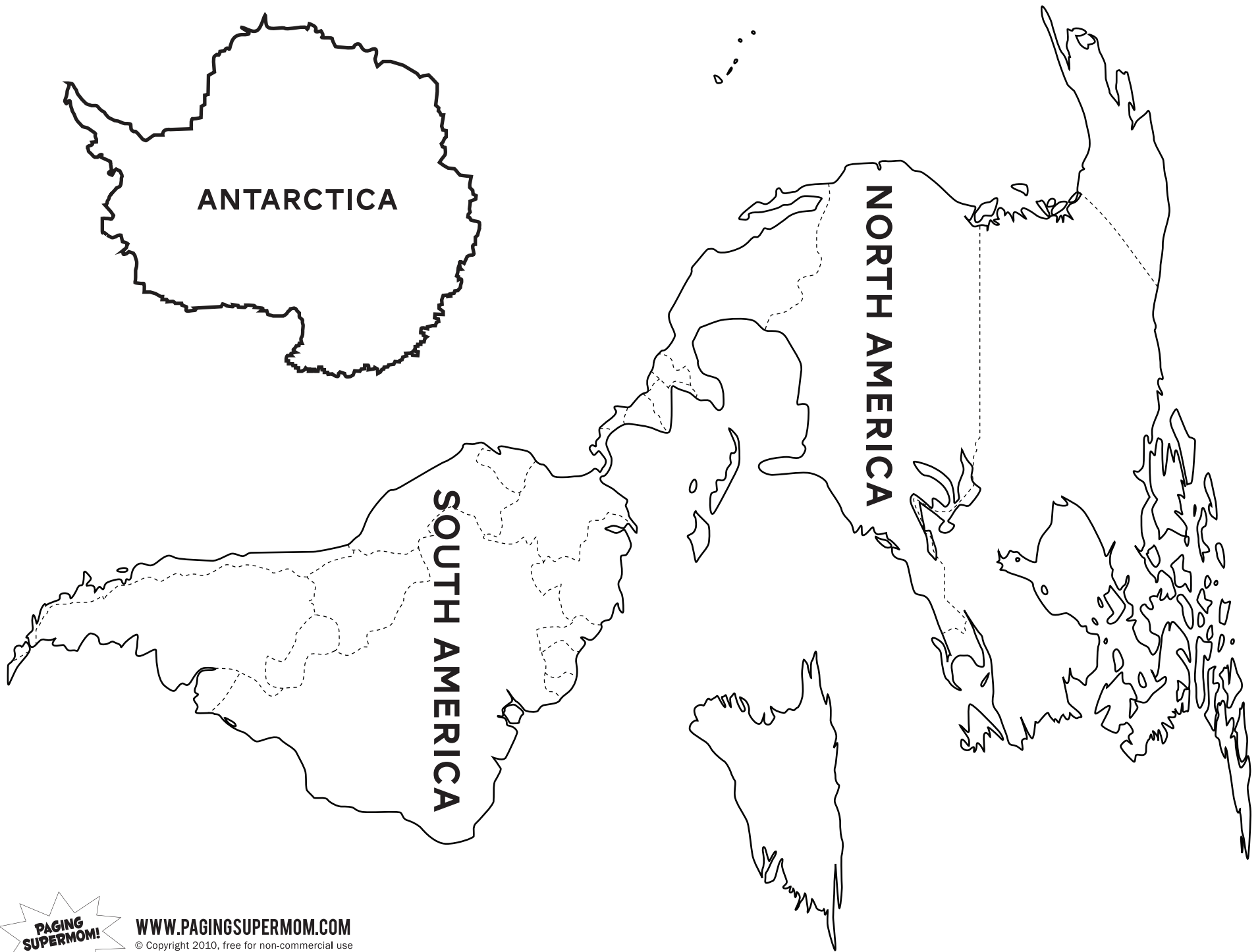
